

Instructions for Foreign Nationals visiting MSU at Stennis Space Center, MS

The NASA Foreign Nationals Management System Visitation Request form, SSC-766, is required for all Foreign National visitors to Stennis Space Center (SSC), MS. The form must be completed and submitted to Sheila Ashley at sheila@hpc.msstate.edu no later than 45 days prior to the planned visit.

If an individual has a green card, they are also required to have a social security number. They are required to bring the green card with them when they visit. Foreign National visitors who do not have a green card must present their visa and passport. The expiration date on both documents must fall after their visit to SSC ends. A copy of these documents must be submitted with the completed SSC-766 form. Those foreign national visitors who come from a country where a visa is waived (e.g., Canada or the UK), must have the waiver with them when they visit SSC.

Individuals from designated countries (see list below) must submit a copy of their current visa and passport (must expire after visit to SSC ends) with the SSC-766 form. These documents must also be presented at the gate when they arrive at SSC.

Each Foreign National visitor to SSC must have a sponsor. The sponsor must be a US citizen and SSC-badged employee. The sponsor will escort the Foreign National visitor(s) at all times, including on tours, to the auditorium, to the cafeteria and atrium, as well to the restroom. The visitor(s) will also be escorted to any space in Building 1021 during the meeting or conference.

This list of "Designated Countries" is a compilation of countries with which the United States has no diplomatic relations, countries determined by Department of State to support terrorism, countries under Sanction or Embargo by the United States and countries of Missile technology Concern. ***Foreign National visitors to NASA from these countries require approval by the Headquarters International Visit Coordinator.*** All NASA mail to these countries require the concurrence of the Headquarters Office of External Relations, in accordance with NPG 1450.10C, NASA Correspondence Management and Communications Standards and Style.
